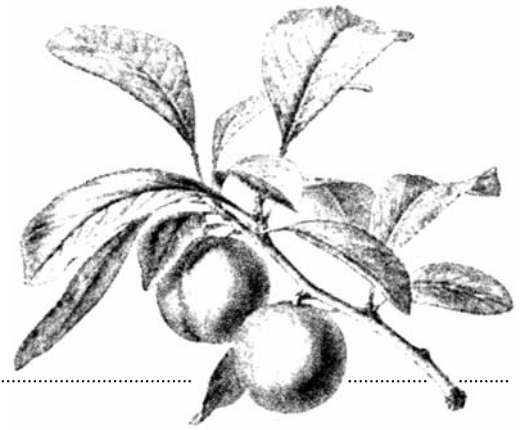




# SOMERVILLE GARDEN CLUB

Vermiculture and other composting techniques, as well as irrigation and the use of rain barrels are also of interest. A garden for consideration should make a good impression in the month of August.
